## School Uniform Expectation

<b>Hairstyles:</b>	Hair should be smartly cut with a natural colour in one tone not noticeably treated (no dip dye allowed). No hair should be cut shorter than grade two, extreme styles not allowed and no patterns shaved, including in eyebrows. Moderate and smart hair accessories are allowed.	SAM/HoY will contact home to inform parents/carers of the concern and to warn that the breach of hairstyle rule should not be repeated. In extreme cases a student can be sent home to rectify the hairstyle concern or be placed in isolation until the hairstyle is deemed acceptable.	<b>Blazer:</b>	Blazer must be worn at all times including to and from school.	Offenders can borrow a blazer from student services in exchange for a personal item. Repeat offenders will be placed into a SLT detention and the SAM/HoY will inform parents/carers.
<b>Earrings and piercing:</b>	One pair of simple studs in the ears only. No sleepers of any size, no ear stretchers/tapers/spike earrings, no large studs, no other visible piercing (nose/lip/eyebrow etc).	Jewellery will be confiscated and given to student services to keep until the end of the day. Unacceptable piercings will be removed or covered up. Repeat offenders will be placed into a SLT detention and the SAM/HoY will inform parents/carers.	<b>Trousers:</b>	Smart, tailored, plain, black trousers of waist height and ankle length. (no jeans or jean style, denim, chinos, cords, combats, hipsters, skinny fit or leggings, recent fashion trend or other casual trousers. No trousers with accessories including leg pockets, zips etc)	The offender spends the day in isolation, or is sent home to change into appropriate clothing.
<b>Make up:</b>	No excessive make-up, including fake tan and heavy eye make-up (no fake eye lashes). No false nails, colourless nail varnish only.	Offenders will be asked to remove the excess make-up. Repeat offenders will be placed into a SLT detention and the SAM/HoY will inform parents/carers.	<b>Skirts:</b>	School tartan school worn at an appropriate length (not to be rolled at the waist).	The offender spends the day in isolation, or is sent home to change into appropriate clothing.
<b>Tie:</b>	The tie must be worn smartly with the top shirt button fastened.	If worn incorrectly a reminder of the school expectation is given. Students without a tie will borrow one from student services in exchange for a personal item. Repeat offenders will be placed into a SLT detention and the SAM/HoY will inform parents/carers.	<b>Tights:</b>	Girls: Must be Plain black or natural coloured tights, no patterns, no leggings. Or plain black socks below the knee. Or ankle length plain black or plain white socks, no other colours allowed. Boys: Dark coloured plain socks only.	If inappropriately worn a student will be reminded of the school expectation and asked to adjust the item. If an item is deemed to be seriously inappropriate the student can be sent home to change or spend the day in isolation. Repeat offenders will be given a SLT detention and the SAM/HoY will inform parents and carers.
<b>Shirt/Blouse:</b>	Boys should wear a plain white shirt with the top button fastened. Girls should wear a plain white shirt with the top button fastened with a tie if wearing trousers. An open neck blouse is permitted with a skirt.	If worn incorrectly a reminder of the school expectation is given. Repeat offenders will be placed into a SLT detention and the SAM/HoY will inform parents/carers.	<b>Coats/jackets:</b>	In cold weather we would expect students to wear a sensible coat. Hooded tops or denim jackets are not to be worn in school.	Offenders will be asked to remove the inappropriate item. Repeat offenders will have the item removed from them for the day and sit a SLT detention; the SAM/HoY will inform parents/carers.
<b>Jumper:</b>	The School jumper with the school badge is the only permitted jumper for Years 7-10. Y11 must wear the designated school jumper for that school year.	Offenders will remove the inappropriate garment. Repeat offenders will have the garment taken from them until the end of the school day and they will be placed into a SLT detention, the SAM/HoY to inform parents/carers.	<b>Shoes:</b>	Plain black leather shoes or leather effect. No trainers or trainer style shoes (regardless of colour), canvas shoes, heeled shoes or boots (over the ankle bone)	Offenders will be provided with plimsolls from student services. Refusal to change shoes will result in isolation or being sent home to change the shoes.
			<b>Jewellery:</b>	One watch, one charity band only, no other jewellery allowed.	Additional items must be removed. Repeat offenders will have the item taken for the day and a SLT detention given, the SAM/HoY will inform parents/carers.
